SOW YOUR SEED BOLDLY

Ecclesiastes 11:1-6

Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 reminds us that we don't know whether God will prosper what we do or not. But we need not be paralyzed by what we don't know. Rather, use every opportunity to act boldly with the wisdom we do know and leave the results with Him.

I. TAKE RISKS WISELY IN DOING GOOD (11:1-2)

1. Send out good, for even the smallest good will return its reward (1)
2. Spread good around while you can, for you don't know the future (2)

II. FRETTING ABOUT THE FUTURE LEADS TO INACTION (11:3-4)

1. Some things are inevitable and random and beyond our control (3)
2. The person paralyzed by life's uncertainties will never get to life's tasks (4)

III. YOU DON'T KNOW GOD'S PLAN, SO TAKE THE INITIATIVE BOLDLY (11:5-6)

1. You don't know God's work any more than how life forms in the womb (5)
2. Since you don't know, sow your seed and keep at it, leaving the result to God-- it may well prosper! (6)
