Praise the Lord we are diligently reaching out to the people in our community and more people are coming to the Bible study. The vision we have for the church plant is one that mimics the diverse community we live in. Please continue to pray as we are actively interacting and meeting new people who need the Lord. We had a family come this week who prefer Spanish so praise the Lord we will be initiating a Spanish study soon.
