Series: *Who Is Like Our God?* (Micah)  
**THE GOD WHO REQUIRES TRUE WORSHIP**  
Micah 6:1-7:7

Micah 6:1-7:7 shows us that God requires from us worship that is grounded in a life of right relationship with Him. He will certainly execute His justice on injustice, but if we find ourselves in a totally corrupt society under His judgment, grieve but don't despair. Look to God for salvation.

**I. GOD REQUIRES WORSHIP GROUNDED IN RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM (6:1-8)**

1. God's case against His unfaithful people: they have not reciprocated His saving love (1-5)
2. God requires not simply the form of worship but worship in life: justice, mercy, and humbly walking with Him (6-8)

**II. GOD WILL CERTAINLY EXECUTE JUSTICE ON INJUSTICE (6:9-16)**

1. Shall God acquit the cheat, the violent, and the liar? No!!! (9-12)
2. God will execute covenant judgment that fits the offences (13-16)

**III. IN A TOTALLY CORRUPT SOCIETY, LOOK TO GOD (7:1-7)**

1. Accusation: the upright removed, the corrupt remain (1-4a)
2. Punishment of a corrupt people: social anarchy (4b-6)
3. Personal testimony: hope in (= worship) my saving God (7)
