Series: *Who Is Like Our God?* (Micah)
THE GOD WHO DELIGHTS IN MERCY
Micah 7:8-20

In Micah 7:8-20 the LORD will restore His repentant, believing people out of judgment to His secure sheepfold and enlarge it for all who come from the nations, for He delights in mercy and forgives sin thoroughly.

I. GOD WILL ANSWER HIS PEOPLE'S HOPE WITH TRIUMPH (7:8-10)

1. In repentance and faith they confess that God will restore them from darkness to light (8-9)
2. Their enemy will be shamed and trampled down (10)

II. GOD'S REMNANT AND THE NATIONS WILL BE GATHERED AND THE EARTH JUDGED (7:11-13)

1. The day will come to rebuild the sheepfold walls and extend the boundary (11)
2. Israel's remnant will be restored to Jerusalem with those from the nations (12)
3. But outside the expanded Jerusalem will be universal judgment (13)

III. GOD WILL AGAIN SHEPHERD HIS PEOPLE AND HUMBLE THE NATIONS (7:14-17)

1. Prayer for the LORD to shepherd His people (14)
2. He will execute a new exodus like their deliverance from Egypt (15)
3. The nations will be humbled and turn to the LORD God in fear (16-17)

IV. GOD WILL FORGIVE HIS PEOPLE IN COVENANT FAITHFULNESS (7:18-20)

1. Who is like God, who forgives their sin and delights in mercy? (18)
2. In compassion He will destroy His people's sins and remove them from sight (19)
3. In covenant loyalty He will faithfully fulfill His ancient promises (20)
