In Ephesians 1:15-23 Paul's example of prayer encourages us to regularly thank God for His work of grace in our fellow believers and pray for the Holy Spirit to enable them to more fully know God and grasp their future hope, their value to God, and His unmatched power for them.

I. *THANKSGIVING* FOR GOD'S SAVING WORK IN FELLOW BELIEVERS
(1:15-16)

1. Thanksgiving for God's grace in conversion and transformation (15)
2. Unceasing thanksgiving in regular prayer (16)

II. *PETITION* FOR GOD'S FURTHER WORK BY THE SPIRIT (1:17-19a)

1. For the Spirit's illumination for greater knowledge of the Father (17)
2. For grasping our hope, value to God, and His unmatched power for us (18-19a)

III. *DOXOLOGY* FOR GOD'S GREAT POWER IN EXALTING CHRIST
(1:19b-23)

1. God's power raised Christ from the dead (19b-20a)
2. God's power seated Christ at God's right hand in heaven above all powers (20b-21)
3. God's power subjected all things under Christ's feet (vss. 22a)
4. God's power gave Christ as head over all things to the church (22b-23)
