WALK IN LOVE

Ephesians 4:25-5:2

Ephesians 4:25-5:2 exhorts us to put off ungodly conduct and attitudes that hurt our life together in Christ and replace them with godly ones that build it up, the foundation of which is love defined and patterned after God's own love for us.

I. UNGODLY CONDUCT REPLACED WITH GODLY CONDUCT (4:25-30)

1. Remove lying and replace it with truthfulness (4:25)
2. Remove uncontrolled anger and replace it with controlled anger (4:26-27)
3. Remove stealing and replace it with honest hard work and generosity (4:28)
4. Remove harmful talk and replace it with talk which builds up (4:29-30)

**II. UNGODLY ATTITUDES REPLACED WITH GODLY ATTITUDES
(4:31-32)**

1. Remove a bitter heart that leads to abusive talk (4:31)
2. Replace with a tender heart that leads to kindness and forgiveness (4:32)

III. CHARACTERIZED BY ONGOING GODLY LOVE (5:1-2)

1. Love in imitation of God as His children who are dearly loved by Him (5:1)
2. Walk in love following Christ's example of self-sacrificing love for us (5:2)
