THE LORD MARCHED OUT

Judges 5:1-31

Judges 5 calls God's people to praise Him for marching forth as their Champion and winning the overwhelming victory over their enemy.

I. PRAISE THE LORD WHO CAME TO THE NEED OF HIS PEOPLE (5:1-8)

1. Praise the LORD and hear the victory song (2-3)
2. The LORD marched forth with a storm to do battle (4-5)
3. The conditions of oppression before the battle (6-8)

II. PRAISE TO THE LORD BECAUSE OF THE VOLUNTEERS (5:9-13)

1. Praise the LORD for both the leaders and the people who responded (9-10)
2. Singing recounting the victory of the LORD and His oppressed people (11-13)

III. THOSE WHO DID OR DID NOT PARTICIPATE (5:14-18)

1. The tribes of Israel who willingly responded to the call to arms (14- 15a)
2. The tribes of Israel who were indifferent and failed to respond (15a-17)
3. The special heroism of the tribes of Zebulun and Naphtali (18)

IV. HOW THE LORD WON THE BATTLE (5:19-23)

1. The LORD nullified the chariots and routed the enemy with a flash flood (19-22)
2. A curse on the people of Meroz for failing to help in the pursuit (23)

V. THE COMPLETENESS OF THE ENEMY'S DEFEAT (5:24-31)

1. The blessedness of Jael for her disposal of Sisera (24-27)
2. The futile wait of Sisera's mother for her son to return with the spoil (28-30)
3. Appeal for justice for all the LORD's enemies and blessing for all His people (31)
