## **THE STRUGGLE OF SUCCESS**

Judges 8:4-32

The spiritual deterioration of Gideon in Judges 8:4-32 following the great success God had given him warns us of how a heart which makes room for subtle compromises to the LORD as our true Ruler will lead to big compromises with widespread impact later.

### **I. TAINING VICTORY FROM THE LORD WITH REVENGE (8:4-21)**

1. Gideon threatens two cities of fearful, doubting Israelites who refuse to aid him (4-9)
2. Gideon secures the victory, capturing the two Midianite kings (10-12)
3. Gideon returns and cruelly teaches the doubters “a lesson” (13-17)
4. Gideon executes the Midianite kings out of revenge (18-21)

### **II. CONFESSING THE LORD AS KING . . . BUT TAKING THE GOLD**

(8:22-27)

1. Gideon refuses the offer of kingship, affirming the LORD is their King (22-23)
2. Gideon makes a golden ephod from the spoil which undercuts God’s kingship (24-27)

### **III. CONTRADICTING THE CONFESSION IN PRIVATE LIFE (8:28-32)**

1. The land has rest from oppression for forty years (28)
2. Gideon, the “non-king,” lives and dies like a king (29-32)

## **JULY 2019: BIRTHDAY MONTH FOR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

As we celebrate the founding of our country this month. Let's remember our founders were religious men with a strong faith in the Lord. This faith extended to the wives and children. This foundation also gives us reason to thank the LORD for this country.

Abigail Adams is the first of only two women in American history to be the wife of one President and the mother of another. Born in 1744 to a Congregationalist minister, her formal education was limited, but her self-education was extensive, and her wisdom and advice caused her to be a trusted adviser to significant Founding Fathers, especially her famous husband, John Adams.

What Abigail taught the young John Quincy Adams never departed him. In fact, when he was quite elderly, he reminisced of her impact upon him, recalling:

*[In the] spring and summer of 1775, she taught me to repeat daily, after the Lord's Prayer, before rising from bed, the Ode of Collins [a patriotic poem] on the patriot warriors who fell in the war. . . . Of the impression made upon my heart by the sentiments inculcated in these beautiful effusions of patriotism and poetry, you may form an estimate by the fact that now, seventy-one years after they were thus taught me, I repeat them from memory.*

From his mother, this great Christian patriot early learned a love of God and a love of his country. But such was the Christian influence of Abigail Adams, a Godly heroine of the American Revolution.
