THE GOOD MISSION OF JESUS' KINGDOM DISCIPLES

Matthew 5:11-16

From Jesus' description of his kingdom disciples as poor in spirit, mourners, meek, etc. we may well wonder what impact such people can possibly have in a world where wealth rules and power is king. Yet, in Matt. 5:11-16 Jesus portrays the vital role our kingdom living really plays in the world he's now redeeming. As his followers who have been given the good life, our role is to benefit the world as his representatives, even in the face of opposition to our good mission.

I. WE ARE IN A GOOD PLACE EVEN WHEN OUR MISSION IS OPPOSED (5:11-12)

1. Devotion and loyalty to Christ brings opposition (11)
2. The promised good far outweighs the present bad and is cause for joy (12a)
3. Such opposition is a token of our genuineness as his representatives (12b)

II. WE ARE GOD'S BENEFICIAL SALT OF THE EARTH (5:13)

1. Like salt, our distinctiveness as kingdom disciples is beneficial (13a)
2. The distinctiveness of our kingdom life is necessary to being beneficial (13b)

III. WE ARE GOD'S ILLUMINATING LIGHT OF THE WORLD (5:14-16)

1. We are the light **together**, not simply many separate points of light (14)
2. We are to be both distinct and at the same time engaged (15-16a)
3. We shine our light that those in the dark might see and glorify God (16b)
